INTRODUCTION

The Company was placed into members’ voluntary liquidation on 28 September 2018 when Emma Cray and David Matthew Hammond were appointed joint liquidators (the liquidators).

We are required to provide you with a final account on the conduct and outcome of the liquidation. This account is for the period 28 September 2018 to 10 July 2019 and also serves as a progress report from 28 September 2018 to 10 July 2019.

We are also required to give you certain information about the Company and the liquidators; this information is attached as Appendix A.

We attach as Appendix B a summary of our receipts and payments for the liquidation.

REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

Realisation of assets:

The directors’ Declaration of Solvency showed that the Company’s assets were:

After our appointment, the Company’s inter group debt was taken under control until distribution.

Realisations from the Company’s assets are as detailed in the above summary and totalled £1.

No additional assets have been identified. There are no assets still to be realised.

Settlement of liabilities:

This section covers all liabilities except any claims of HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) which are dealt with separately below under HMRC.

The directors’ Declaration of Solvency and the Company’s records showed the Company had no liabilities.

After our appointment we published a notice in the Gazette inviting any unknown creditors to send in their claims. No such claims were received.

HMRC:

The directors’ Declaration of Solvency and the Company’s records showed that the Company had no tax liabilities.

After our appointment, we wrote to HMRC to inform them of our appointment and to request details of any outstanding liabilities. HMRC have confirmed their agreement to us closing the liquidation.

Distributions to shareholders:

At the time of our appointment, the issued share capital of the Company consisted of 1 Ordinary £1 shares.

On 4 June 2019 we made a distribution in specie of £1 (representing 1 pound per share) to the shareholder.

The distribution in specie consisted of an inter-group debtor balance together with any other assets held by the Company. The value attributed to the in specie distribution was based on the value at which the asset was held in the Company's books.

OUR FEES AND EXPENSES

Basis of remuneration:

At the time of our appointment, a resolution was passed for us to be paid by reference to the time properly given by us and our staff in dealing with the liquidation.

Funding of the liquidation:

Although fees have been paid to us on the basis specified above, our fees and expenses have not been paid out of the liquidation estate. Instead, Tarmac Trading Limited has met our fees and expenses for the Company and 10 connected companies.

Remuneration charged:

Our fees for undertaking this assignment consist of time costs incurred for the period covering the formal liquidation. Our time costs for the period and agreed costs to close are:

The above time costs for the liquidation period are calculated to 7 June 2019, being the latest practicable date. This represents 33 hours at an average hourly rate of £278.24.

£10,647 has been invoiced for this case. It is our normal practice to obtain the prior approval of Tarmac Trading Limited before fees are invoiced. No further billing will take place.

Liquidators' expenses:

During the liquidation of the Company and 10 connected companies we have incurred expenses of £1,285 plus VAT. These costs, which will be or have been re-charged, consist of:
