1 Introduction and Statutory Information

- 1.1 I, Lauren Rachel Cullen of Cullen & Co UK Limited, 197 Kingston Road, Epsom, Surrey, KT19 0AB, was appointed as Liquidator of The Pilates Practice Limited (the Company) on 22 July 2021. This report provides an update on the progress in the liquidation for year ended 21 July 2022 (the Period).

2 Progress of the Liquidation

2.1 Attached, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period, with a comparison to the Declaration of Solvency (**DoS**) values.

2.2 Cash at Bank

The Declaration of Solvency showed cash at bank of £3,899.62. This sum was received in full on my appointment.

2.3 Director's Loan Account

Prior to the liquidation, the Company's director withdrew funds totalling £70,682.30 in the form of a Director's Loan. This sum was distributed in specie to the sole member on the date of appointment.

2.4 Tax Refund

The Declaration of Solvency showed a tax refund due to the Company of £49,010.00, this in relation to s455 tax and HM Revenue & Customs will only release this when the liquidation is 21 months' old so should be shown in the next report. Once this has been received, I will conclude the liquidation.

3 Creditors' Claims

Unsecured Creditors

- 3.1 The company's accountants were owed £2,368.80 in relation to fees. No funds were held in the liquidation for creditors and the sole member therefore repaid her capital distribution to equal this sum. The accountant was paid in full on 30 July 2021 and no interest was due.
- 3.2 An advertisement for claims was placed in the London Gazette, giving a deadline for the submission of claims of 25 August 2021. No response was received.

4 Distributions to Members

- 4.1 Distributions to the members totalled £68,313.50, this comprised of the distribution in specie of £70,682.30 referenced at 2.3 and then a repayment of £2,368.80 referenced at 3.1.
- 4.2 This represents a distribution to shareholders of £34,156.75 per share.

5 Liquidator's Remuneration

- 5.1 The members approved that the basis of the Liquidator's remuneration be fixed as a set amount of £2,750 plus VAT and disbursements.
- 5.2 The Liquidator has been paid the full amount of the total set fee approved by the members.
