The Park has now completed the first full trading year

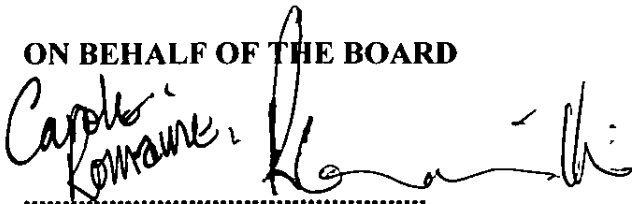

1. EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT

The members have not required the company to obtain an audit of the financial statements for the 12 months ended 30 September 2009 in accordance with Section 249B(2) of the Companies Act 1985.

Independent Examiner's Report – Accounts year ended 30 September 2009

Report to the trustees of

My examination was carried out in accordance with the general directions given by the Charity Commissioners. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

In connection with my examination, no matter has come to my attention

- 1 which gives me reasonable cause to believe that in any material respect the requirements
 - (a) to keep accounting records in accordance with section 41 of the Act, and
 - (b) to prepare accounts which accord with the accounting records and to comply with the accounting requirements of the Act

have not been met, or

- 2 to which in my opinion, attention should be drawn in order to enable a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached. I wish to point out that if an inspection takes place by an officer of HM Revenue and Customs, I expect that this inspection would initially focus on the substantial amounts of VAT which have been reclaimed by the Trust on the on-going construction work. A visit has taken place and no recovery action is to be taken by H M Revenue and Customs.
