My examination was carried out in accordance with the general directions given by the Charity Commissioners. I wish to point out that if an inspection takes place by an officer of HM Revenue and Customs, I expect that this inspection would initially focus on the substantial amounts of VAT which have been reclaimed by the Trust on the on-going construction work. A visit has taken place and no recovery action is to be taken by H M Revenue and Customs.
