UPON READING the First Applicant's Application dated 23 November 2020 pursuant to Chapter 6 (Subdivision B) of part 12 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 (SI/2016/1024)

AND UPON READING the Witness Statements of Edward Williams (dated 17 November 2020), Nigel Morrison (dated 17 November 2020), Jon Roden (dated 17 November 2020) and Richard Hicken (dated 12 November 2020) respectively.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- Each of the County Court and hearing centre cases listed in Schedules 1 to 3 hereto ("County Court Cases") be transferred to the High Court of Justice, Business and Property Courts of England and Wales, Insolvency and Companies List (ChD) for the purpose only of making this Order. Immediately upon this Order taking effect, the County Court Cases be transferred back to the relevant County Court or hearing centre.
- Edward Williams ("First Applicant") be removed as Officeholder to be replaced by Jon Roden, Nigel Morrison and Richard Hicken as officeholders ("Replacement Officeholders") as applicable, as set out in paragraphs 3 to 5 below and in Schedules 1 to 3 attached hereto. The consents of the Replacement Officeholders to act are contained in their witness statements.
- The First Applicant be removed from office as Joint Administrator of the companies in Administration listed in Schedule 1 attached hereto with effect from the date of this Order and either Nigel Morrison be appointed in substitution as Joint Administrator of the said companies or the remaining officeholder will continue as Sole Administrator of the said companies, as specified in Schedule 1, with effect from the date of this Order, pursuant to paragraphs 88 and 95 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 and rule 12.36(2) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016.
- The First Applicant be removed from office as Sole and/or Joint Liquidator of the companies in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation listed in Schedule 2 attached hereto with effect from the date of this Order and, where indicated, either the individual or individuals named as Replacement Officeholder in Schedule 2 be appointed in substitution as Joint Liquidator or Joint Liquidators, as applicable, in respect of the said companies or the remaining officeholder will continue as Sole Liquidator or Joint Liquidator with the existing joint appointee of the said companies, as specified in Schedule 2, with effect from the date of this Order, pursuant to Section 108 of the Insolvency Act 1986.

- The First Applicant be removed from office as Joint Liquidator of the companies in Compulsory Liquidation listed in Schedule 3 attached hereto with effect from the date of this Order and either Richard Hicken be appointed in substitution as Joint Liquidator of the said companies or the remaining officeholder will continue as Sole Liquidator of the said companies, as specified in Schedule 3, with effect from date of this Order, pursuant to Section 172(2) of the Insolvency Act 1986 and rule 12.36(2) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016.
- The First Applicant be removed and replaced, as set out at paragraphs 3 to 5 above, in each of the cases contained in Schedules 1 to 3 from the date of this Order, without being required to (i) apply to the Secretary of State for release or discharge as appropriate pursuant to Section 173(2)(b) and Section 174(4)(b) of the Insolvency Act 1986 as the case may be or (ii) file a receipts and payment account.
- Where the appointments referred to in this Order are joint appointments, any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by joint appointees may be done by all or any one or more of the persons at the time being holding office. No functions are required to be undertaken by both joint appointees acting together and no functions are specifically the responsibility of either joint appointee.
- The Applicants, Respondents or Replacement Officeholder shall file a copy of this Order with the relevant court listed in respect of any of the estates referred to in any of the Schedules hereto.
- The relevant Applicant, Respondents or Replacement Officeholder shall notify each creditor of this Application and this Order by way of notice at the same time as the next routine report that shall be due to the creditors of each estate, such notice to contain the following matters:
 - 9.1 An explanation of the effect of the Order;
 - 9.2 Express reference to the liberty to apply contained in paragraph 10 below;
 - 9.3 Where Liquidation Committees or Creditors' Committees have been appointed, an explanation that, to the extent that any information which would otherwise be required to be provided under rule 3.63, rule 6.25 or rule 7.61 (as the case may be) of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 has not already been provided as part of the report, it is open to that committee to require the relevant Applicant, Respondent or Replacement Officeholder to provide an account of the administration of the estate, including:
 - 9.3.1 a summary of receipts and payments; and
 - 9.3.2 a statement that he has reconciled his accounts.

- 9.4 Where no Liquidation Committees or Creditors' Committees have been appointed, an explanation that, to the extent that such information as aforesaid has not already been provided as part of the report, it is open to any creditor to apply to court for an order that the relevant Applicant, Respondent or Replacement Officeholder do provide an account of the administration of the estate, including:
 - 9.4.1 a summary of receipts and payments; and
 - 9.4.2 a statement that he has reconciled his accounts.
- 9.5 Notification that if any Applicant, Respondent or Replacement Officeholder has been required to provide the information referred to in sub-paragraphs 9.3 and 9.4 above, whether by a Liquidation Committee or Creditors' Committee or by court order on the application of any creditor(s), the costs of any appointed officeholder of so complying will, unless there are good reasons to the contrary, be paid as an expense of the liquidation or administration, as the case may be.
- 9.6 In the case of Liquidations in Schedules 2 and 3, notification to each creditor of his right under regulation 11(2) of the Insolvency Regulations 1994 to require the appointed officeholders to supply a statement of receipts and payments free of charge.
- 9.7 In the case of the Administrations in Schedule 1, the provision of all such information as might reasonably be required with regard to the conduct of the Administrations.
- The Respondents shall, when the next routine report is due to the creditors of each appointment, give written notice of the making of this Order to each such creditor, such notice to include the following matters:
 - 10.1 an explanation as to the effect of the Order; and
 - 10.2 express reference to the liberty to apply as set out in the Order.
- The creditors in each of the cases listed in Schedules 1 to 3 shall be notified of this Order by way of one composite notice ("the Advertisement") to be published in the Gazette within 28 days of receipt of the sealed Order.
- Each creditor of each estate listed in Schedules 1 to 3, who has an objection to this Order, has liberty to apply to vary or discharge this Order. Creditors shall have 21 days from the date of the Advertisement to apply to Court to set aside or vary the terms of this Order. Such application shall

not affect the transfer of the case as listed in Schedules 1 to 3 until further or other order by the Court.
