INTRODUCTION

Galileo Brick Limited (Entity) entered members' voluntary liquidation on 26 October 2017, Emma Cray and Toby Scott Underwood were appointed joint liquidators of the Entity (Liquidators).

This report covers the conduct and progress of the liquidation in the period from 26 October 2019 to 25 October 2020 ("the Period") and should be read in conjunction with the Liquidators' previous progress reports covering the period from 26 October 2017 to 25 October 2019.

A summary of receipts and payments for this period is at attached Appendix A.

The statutory information relating to the Entity and the Liquidators is at Appendix B.

REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

Realisation of assets

As previously reported, we took control of the intercompany receivables following our appointment.

No other assets have been identified during the Period and we are not aware of any other assets still to be realised.

Settlement of liabilities

As previously reported, the directors' Declaration of Solvency indicated that the Entity had an outstanding liability upon entering liquidation, being an intercompany creditor totalling £35,000. No claim has been received in respect of this sum and no payment has been made in settlement during the Period.

During the Period, we did not become aware of any other actual of contingent liabilities of the Entity.

HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC)

Whilst HMRC clearance has been received, we have been asked by the group's tax advisors to refrain from closing the liquidations until they have assessed the Group's loss position. Once we have received clarity from the tax advisors, we will then be in a position to proceed to distribute and close the liquidation.

Distributions to shareholders

No distributions were made during the Period, pending confirmation of approval from the Entity's indirect owner, which is expected in early 2021.

OUR FEES AND EXPENSES

Basis of remuneration

At the time of our appointment, a resolution was passed for us to be paid by reference to the time properly given by us and our staff in dealing with the liquidation.
