#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

#### Objectives and aims

The object of the charity is to provide or assist in the provision of facilities for the recreation or other leasure time occupation for the benefit of the community of St Just and the surrounding district.

During the year the charity has continued to operate the St Just Sports Centre, and has increased the use of both sports hall and the gym for the benefit of the local community. Improvements have been made to the gym equipment, and some refurbishment of the centre has been carried out in order to maintain a high standard. Reviews have been commenced in an attempt to improve the energy efficiency of the building.

We review our aims, objectives and activities at least once each year to look at what we have achieved in the previous 12 months. We have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing our aims and objectives and in planning our future activities. In particular, the trustees consider how planned activities will contribute to aims and objectives they have set.

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008), the Companies Act 2006 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities

#### Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy

#### Resources expended

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

#### Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life

Solar panel equipment

- 5% on cost

Other equipment

- at varying rates on cost

#### Stock

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items

#### Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities

#### Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements
