REVIEW OF BUSINESS AND FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

The remaining investment within Melville Crescent Ventures Limited will continue to be managed as in prior years and an exit will be sought at the appropriate time. The profitability of this development will determine the recovery of the Company's investment in Melville Crescent Ventures Limited and the subordinated loan made to MCV Port Talbot Limited. It is the directors' opinion that the provision against the investment in Melville Crescent Ventures Limited and the subordinated loan should continue to be in force in 2011. The company has also continued to provide in full for the amount owed by the parent undertaking Eldon Street Holdings Limited.

No dividend was received from Melville Crescent Ventures Limited during the year (2010 - £nil)

The ultimate parent undertaking of Eldon Street (Birchin) Limited, Lehman Brothers Holdings Inc, incorporated in the State of Delaware in the United States of America, filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection on 15 September 2008 Subsequent to this event, the immediate parent undertaking of Eldon Street (Birchin) Limited, Eldon Street Holdings Limited, went into administration on 9 December 2008

Following the events noted above the Company no longer has a continuing trade and there are no plans for the company to re-invest in property or joint ventures, accordingly, these financial statements have not been prepared on a going concern basis. The impact of this is discussed in note 1 of the financial statements.
