#### 1 General information

The company is a private company limited by share capital incorporated in England. The registered office is shown on page 1.

#### 2 Accounting policies

#### Statement of compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 Section 1A Small Entities and the Companies Act 2006.

#### **Basis of preparation**

These financial statements have been prepared using the historical cost convention except where otherwise disclosed in these accounting policies certain items are shown at fair value.

The financial statements are presented in sterling which is the functional currency of the company and rounded to the nearest £.

#### Summary of significant accounting policies

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the years presented, unless otherwise stated.

#### Tax

The tax expense for the period comprises current and, where applicable deferred tax. Tax is recognised in profit or loss, except that a change attributable to an item of income or expense recognised as other comprehensive income or to an item recognised directly in equity is also recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity respectively.

The company's liability for current tax is calculated using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the end of the reporting period.

Deferred tax is recognised on all timing differences arising between the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities in the financial statements and the corresponding tax bases used in the computation of taxable profit. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the reporting date and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

The carrying amount of deferred tax assets are reviewed at each reporting date and a valuation allowance is set up against deferred tax assets so that the net carrying amount equals the highest amount that is more likely than not to be recovered based on current or future taxable profit.

Current and deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.

#### Notes to the Unaudited Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31 May 2019

#### Tangible assets

Tangible assets are stated in the Balance Sheet at cost, less any subsequent accumulated depreciation and subsequent accumulated impairment losses.

The cost of tangible assets includes directly attributable incremental costs incurred in their acquisition and installation.

#### Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on tangible assets so as to write off the cost, less any estimated residual value, evenly over their estimated useful economic life, as follows:

#### Goodwill

Goodwill arising on the acquisition of an entity represents the excess of the cost of acquisition over the company's interest in the net fair value of the identifiable assets, liabilities and contingent liabilities of the entity recognised at the date of acquisition. Goodwill is initially recognised as an asset at cost and is subsequently measured at cost less accumulated amortisation and accumulated impairment losses. Goodwill is amortised over its useful life.

#### Amortisation

Amortisation is provided on intangible assets so as to write off the cost over their estimated useful economic life, as follows:

#### Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash at bank and in hand.

#### Financial instruments

#### Classification

Financial liabilities and equity are classified according to the substance of the financial instrument's contractual obligations, rather than its legal form.

#### Recognition and measurement

The company's cash at bank and in hand, other debtors, trade and other creditors are measured initially at transaction price, and subsequently at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

#### Trade debtors

Trade debtors are amounts due from customers for goods sold or services provided in the ordinary course of business.

Trade debtors are recognised at the transaction price. A provision for the impairment of trade debtors is established when there is objective evidence that the company will not be able to collect all amounts due according to the original terms of the receivables.

#### Notes to the Unaudited Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31 May 2019

#### Stocks

Stocks are stated at the lower of cost and estimated selling price less costs to complete and sell. Cost is determined using the first-in, first-out (FIFO) method. Net realisable value is based on estimated selling price less additional costs of disposal.

#### Trade creditors

Trade creditors are obligations to pay for goods or services that have been acquired in the ordinary course of business from suppliers. Trade creditors are classified as current liabilities if the company does not have an unconditional right, at the end of the reporting period, to defer settlement of the creditor for at least twelve months after the reporting date. If there is an unconditional right to defer settlement for at least twelve months after the reporting date, they are presented as non-current liabilities. Trade creditors are recognised at the transaction price.

#### Leases

Leases in which substantially all the risks and rewards of ownership are retained by the lessor are classified as operating leases. Payments made under operating leases are charged to profit or loss on a straight-line basis over the period of the lease.

#### Dividends

Final equity dividends are recognised when they become legally payable. Interim equity dividends are recognised when paid.

#### Pension costs

Contributions to the company's defined contribution pension scheme are charged to the statement of income in the year. The assets of the scheme are held separately from those of the company in an independently administered fund. In addition, the pension costs also include the amount paid by the company into the director's personal pension plan.

#### 3 Employee information

The average number of persons employed by the company (including the director) during the year, was 40 (2018 - 40).
