AND UPON READING the evidence

IT IS ORDERED

 That the Applicants have leave to make a composite application in respect of the insolvency proceedings identified in the Schedules A to F attached to this Order (the "Schedules")

- That the proceedings listed in the Schedules, in so far as there are currently proceedings in any County Court or any District Registry in England and Wales other than the Birmingham District Registry, be transferred to the Birmingham District Registry solely for the purpose of considering, and if thought fit, making this Order.
- 3. That the Applicants do ensure that a sealed copy of every order transferring any case to this Court and of every order which may be made as a result of this application be lodged with the Court having jurisdiction over each case affected by such order for filing on the Court file relating to that case.
- 4. That the time for service of this application be abridged.
- Pursuant to Section 108(2) of the Act, the First Respondent be removed from his office as joint liquidator of the company identified in Schedule A hereto as being in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation.
- 6. Pursuant to Section 108(2) of the Act, the First Applicant be appointed as joint liquidator of the company identified in Schedule A hereto as being in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation
- 7. Pursuant to Section 108(2) of the Act the First Respondent be removed from his office as liquidator of the companies identified in Schedule B, Part 1 hereto as being in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation.
- 8. Pursuant to Section 108(2) of the Act, the First Applicant and Jeremy Nigel Ian Woodside (the "Second Applicant"), be appointed as joint liquidators of the companies identified in Schedule B, Part 1 hereto as being in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation
- Pursuant to Section 108(2) of the Act, the First Respondent be removed from his office as joint liquidator of the companies identified in Schedule B, Part 2 hereto as being in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation
- Pursuant to Section 108(2) of the Act, the First Applicant be appointed as joint liquidator of the companies identified in Schedule B, Part 2 hereto as being in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation.

- 14. Pursuant to Section 168(3) and (5) of the Act and Rule 7 10B(2) of the Rules the First and Second Applicants and be appointed as Joint liquidators of the companies identified in Schedule D hereto as being subject to Compulsory Winding Up Orders

- 15. Pursuant to Section 7(5) and Paragraph 39(6) of Schedule A1 to the Act, the First Respondent be removed from his office as joint supervisor of the company identified in Schedule E hereto.
- Pursuant to Section 7(5) and Paragraph 39(6) of Schedule A1 to the Act, the Second Applicant be appointed as joint supervisor of the company identified in Schedule E hereto;
- 17. Pursuant to Section 298 of the Act and Rule 7.10B(2) of the Rules the First Respondent be removed from his office as sole trustee in bankruptcy of the individuals listed in Schedule F attached hereto.
- 18. Pursuant to Sections 298 and 303(2) of the Act and Rule 7.10B(2) of the Rules Mark Robin Sands (the "Third Applicant"), be appointed as sole trustee in bankruptcy of the individuals listed in Schedule F attached hereto.
- The creditors of the companies listed in the Schedules be notified of this Order by advertisement in the London Gazette within 14 days of the date of this Order and at the time of the next statutory reporting requirement for each case.
- 20. The Applicants shall notify the Secretary of State of this Order as soon as reasonably practicable after it is made.
- 21. All creditors of the companies and individuals listed in the Schedules do have permission to apply to the Court, on notice to the Applicants, within 28 days of being given notice of the terms of this Order for the purposes of applying to vary or discharge the Order in so far as it affects the company or companies or bankruptcy estates of which they are a creditor.
- 22. There be no order as to costs save that the Applicants' costs of this application be charged as a cost or expense of the estates listed in the Schedules with each estate to bear such share as the Applicants have proposed under cover of their letter dated 29 November 2012 (attached) (which approximates to 1% of the available funds in the various estates).
- Any cases listed in the Schedules which, pursuant to paragraph 2 above are transferred to the Birmingham District Registry be transferred back to the County Court or District Registry from which they originated immediately prior to the making of this Order.

Dear Sire.

We refer to our application for a block transfer order in connection with the insolvency cases in respect of which Malihew Bowker is the outgoing office holder. In the dreft order we have asked for the costs of this block transfer application to be paid as an expense of the various insolvency proceedings, either:

- 1. An equal share between the estates concerned (there being 37); or
- 2. As we may deolde; and
- 3. With a maximum of 10% of the value of the available assets of a particular estate,

The purpose of this letter is to provide more information in relation to the funds available in the transferring cases to the honourable court.

1. Value of assets comprised in those cases:

The value of realisations in any particular case varies over time. At present, on a very quick analysis using the most recent Receipts and Payments accounts we have put together a schedulo (enclosed) to provide an answer to that question. However, it will continue to vary depending on the success and quantum of further realisations.

2. Value and extent of the costs involved:

The costs of the application are as follows: Solicitors - £2,000 plus VAT; Court (es - £155; and Counsel's fee - £500 plus VAT.

Including VAT that totals £3155. Between 37 estates that would be approximately £85.27 par onso.

However, the court might wish to apply the costs based upon the pro rata value of each estate. Using the enclosed schedule we have inserted a second column which adjusts the contribution to costs based upon the value of the assets.

We hope this assists the court when deckling whether it is appropriate to order that the costs be pald as an expense.
