TRUSTEES' REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2008

The trustees present their report and the accounts for the year ended 31 March 2008.

Charitable objects

The charity's objects are to promote any charitable purpose for the benefit of the community in Penwith, Kerrier and Carrick ("the area of benefit") by the advancement of education, the protection and preservation of health and the relief of poverty, sickness and distress.

Review of activities and achievements

The Partnership continued to recruit and train CAB volunteers for the benefit of Penwith, Kerrier and Carrick Bureaux. Two training courses were completed during the year and two more are planned for 2008-2009. The Court Desk project, managed by Kerrier Bureau, for the benefit of Penwith, Kerrier and Carrick Districts was continued during the year.

The trustees are actively considering further projects to utilise the balance of funds.

Statement of trustees' responsibilities

1. Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective June 2005) and follow the recommendations in Statement of Recommended Practice – Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) issued in March 2005.

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Companies Act, except that they do not include an income and expenditure account in the form specified by the Companies Act 1985.
