Notes to the abbreviated accounts

1 Accounting policies

a) Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2007) and under historical cost accounting rules.

b) Tangible fixed assets

All fixed assets are initially recorded at cost.

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of an asset, less its estimated residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows:

Fixtures, fittings and equipment 20% straight line

c) Taxation

The charge for taxation is based on the profit for the year and takes into account taxation deferred because of timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes.

Deferred tax is recognised, without discounting, in respect of all timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes which have arisen but not reversed by the balance sheet date, except as otherwise required by FRS 19.

d) Leases

Assets acquired under finance leases are capitalised and the outstanding future lease obligations are shown in creditors. Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all of the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the less or are charged against profits on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.
