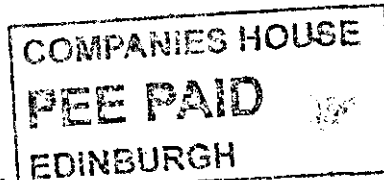

NOTES:

1. The original instrument (if any) creating or evidencing the charge, together with these prescribed particulars correctly completed must be delivered to the Registrar of Companies within 21 days after the date of creation of the charge (section 395). If the property is situated and the charge was created outside the United Kingdom delivery to the Registrar must be effected within 21 days after the date on which the instrument could in due course of post, and if dispatched with due diligence, have been received in the United Kingdom (section 398). A copy of the instrument creating the charge will be accepted where the property charged is situated and the charge was created outside the United Kingdom (section 398) and in such cases the copy must be verified to be a correct copy either by the company or by the person who has delivered or sent the copy to the registrar. “the Bank” means the Governor and Company of the Bank of Scotland, acting through its offices at New Uberior House, 11 Earl Grey Street, Edinburgh, EH3 9BN.

“the Charge” means the legal charge by the Chargor in favour of the Bank dated 30 July 2004 and to be recorded in HM Land Registry.

“the Chargor” means Brannigans Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts with registered number 04636778 whose registered office is at 97 Church Street, Blackpool, Lancashire, FY1 1HL.

“Conditions” means the Bank’s Commercial Charge Conditions (2003 Edition).

“Debt” has the same meaning as in the Conditions, being all sums of money owed by the Chargor to the Bank from time to time.

“Property” means the freehold property known as land and buildings at Tunbridge Wells West Station, Montacute Road, Tunbridge Wells and registered at HM Land Registry under Title Number K675465.

“Rental Sums” has the same meaning as in the Conditions.

- 1.1 by way of legal mortgage the Property;
