Port Vale (Valiant 2001) Football Club Limited

Matters arising from the meeting of creditors and members held on 26 April 2012 at Vale Park, Hamil Road, Burslem, Stoke on Trent, ST6 1AW

- Q Gary Benson, Shareholder From what has been said today can you clear up categorically for everyone's benefit re the two stones in the Sentinel, one claiming the Administration process would cost the Council £1 million on top the monies they are not going to get back from their loan and the second one being the Council will get £1 3 million
- Α RMY - Agree lots of people talking to the press and information has been misleading. The cost to the Council from the Administration process so far is £200,000, this may be a little more before the process is finished All remaining costs of the Administration process, being our professional fees, solicitors and trading losses since appointment as Administrators until end of June are all paid out of the sale proceeds, so the cost to the Council so far has been £200k but will actually be nil and there will be a return to the Council of several hundred thousand pounds from the deal that has been accepted. We do not know at this stage exactly what this will be as the trading costs and revenue income until the end of the season are unknown. But from the cashflow forecast presented to the Council and revised monthly are pretty sure there will be a return to the Council of several hundred thousand pounds against the debt of £1 8 million. As to where the figures come from is baffling, either individual councillors must be talking to the press, got hold of figures and added them up twice to get to the figures quoted The council will suffer a write off, there is no additional cost to them and will get a return on their original investment from the sale of the ground, and from anything recovered from the antecedent transactions The eventual council write off from the original loan may well be about £1 million, but suspect this is where the million pound has arisen from , it's the amount the council will end up short on their original investment of £2 25 million. There has been a lot of mixed reporting, Mike Baggaley wrote a very good article last week which was very balanced and thanks to Mike for that, equally some colleagues have written a disgraceful article, the front page article implying that Keith Ryder had gone with a begging bowl to the Council asking for £550,000 The council asked for that conversation to be kept confidential when we originally accepted the deal, which we did

GMK – The sentinel normally contact Bob or I to clear up the figures but neither of us were contacted about the last stories, if they had we would have put them right

- Q Peter Davies, Partner & Sales Director, Regal Sports Press The value of stadium/land in the books is £5.2 million, realistic realisation is £800,000, now possibly £700,000 with what Keith has done with the Council. How can this have been built up within the accounts and shown as such an asset reflecting as it would have done on the balance sheet.
- A GMK In GMK report a point was made that that value must be a development value for residential land. From previous experience with dealing with Leeds united where several valuations were obtained ranging from £8 Million to £29 million and the current value noted in the accounts says it is worth £56 million, which shows until you come to sell it you do not know what it is worth. Therefore it can only be residential value. These are questions the directors are going to have to answer to the Liquidator.

RMY – To be specific the Valiant 2001 bought the land from me as Administrator last time around for £800,000, which was subsequently revalued several times, the first being £4.5 million (by creating a Revaluation Reserve in the accounts of £3.7 million), and in the last year, from the draft accounts, there was a further upward valuation by £600,000 to £5.1 million Draw your own conclusions as to why this was done but the valuations have been seen and the valuation of £5.1 million was for this site for housing. As a football ground the valuation BJB

provided me in 2002 as a football ground unless kept in the football league it may be worth £400,000, as a football stadium in the football league possibly £800,000. The valuations this year for this Admin the figures are very similar.

GMK – It would help future Joint Liquidators if you could give us a statement of what was said to you by the directors and what information was given to you about the value of land Peter Davies agreed he would

- Q Peter Davies Was talked into a contract last July, the figures provided were fraudulent, it was 2 year contract, when started to fall apart when you could see the numbers were not adding up around Sept/Oct approached 2 members of the board to see if we could readjust, basically we were ignored but continued to supply and has now compounded our losses. There is the second year of the contract to run, this could be null and void but would very much like to continue with the contract to try to mitigate some losses. From the supporters meeting RMY said certain contractors may continue and I would like RMY assurance that I could have the opportunity to talk to Keith Ryder to take this forward.
- A RMY Will mention to Keith They way contracts will be worded as with any Administrator sale contracts is that we will assign any such right, title and interest as the company has in those contracts to the purchaser for £1, it will then be for the purchaser to negotiate with people who have got contracts like yourself to decide whether to adopt those contracts or not. One or two of those contracts are fairly onerous and unlikely those will be taken forward, yours may not necessarily fall into that category, therefore given what has happened I will personally mention this to Keith
- Q Peter Burton, Shareholder Referring to S1 Paragraph 10 of our document referring to other information to assist creditors, which reads "As Administrators of the Company we require that the best practise intends to make enquiries of creditors as to whether they wish to raise any concerns regarding the way which the company's was conducted prior to the commencement of the Administration." This means going back 3 years for the conduct of the directors. Will you be sending out some kind of proforma to ask creditors whether they've got anything to raise or will you leave it if you like the finding through this document whether they've got a problem.
- A GMK We will not be sending a specific questionnaire to all the creditors, the creditors have had this document a number of people have approached us before today raising concerns. We have a long list and some of these concerns are duplicated from different sources. Our job is to collate the information, the look through the company's books and records, to go to the company's solicitors and accountants and if there is a committee of creditors, and I personally would like a committee of creditors for the Liquidation, to liaise with them on a confidential basis as to what we intend to do when we put the jigsaw together. We've got the press here, I would like to see a short paragraph in the paper asking creditors to send in details of any such concerns that they may have

RMY – We have Steve Grocott and Liam Norcup from Grindeys on side table, who are our solicitors, they are helping to investigate the antecedent transactions. Any creditors who have anything specific that they would like us to investigate please write to or email us with your concerns. We are taking our investigations seriously and Arthur Bailey, one of my consultants and who was a senior partner at what was Bentley Jennison, whom some of you may know, is spending most of his time assisting with this matter. We have also had contact with the police in case there is anything that may be fraudulent or criminal, and we will, certainly once we are liquidators, which is when most of our powers arise, we will be looking to formulate a creditors committee and I think at that point I will be very happy to talk to Gary to see if he or Keith will come on board on behalf of the supporters consortium so that you can channel your views to the committee via them as your representatives.

- Q Source Unknown Re comments in the sentinel, I would like to see the comments put in the Sentinel that were incorrect, the figures not fact and the scaremongering that has been caused through it, be put right
- Α RMY - Will chat to the Sentinel afterwards but if Mike wishes to say something, who is here as a creditor, I will let Mike respond. You have to understand that the Sentinel are given a lot of information by a lot of different people who have all got vested interests. We have seen an article in today's Sentinel quoting Mo Chaudry saying that he put in the highest bid. Suffice to say Mo's gone public with his bid and not signed a confidentiality clause, so to be specific, I have not got his offer with me but I think his offer was £550,000for football assets and £200,000 premium on a 150 year lease, so that would represent a peppercorn lease of one peppercorn for 150 years which equates to £1,333 per annum. It would have given the council no return whatsoever on its investments, it might or might not just about recovered the costs. Mo has got an angle that he wants to peddle and so have some of the councillors got an angle politically that they want to peddle, so the Sentinel are getting a lot of different stories from a lot of different angles You have to understand the Sentinel only report what they are told Now I have been very critical about the article with the implication of Keith holding his hand up and for a begging bowl, that certainly was not the case and I have to say it was a very poor example of redtop journalism at its worst, but notwithstanding that overall the Sentinel reporting has been fairly balanced
- A Mike Baggaley, the Sentinel commenting on the scaremongering, we do chase up and check information received and the information comes from good sources at the Council, and I must defend my colleagues at the Sentinel
- Q Alan Whatmore, Creditor and Shareholder There is a football club in Scotland called Rangers which has got some similar problems to this one. Having had 10 points deducted this season they've now been hammered by another £160,000 fine from the SFA. Is there any indication that the FA are going to do anything like that to this club
- A GMK Firstly can I say that Rangers' problems are 100 times worse than what PVFC have got, their wage bill for one month is more than PVFC wage bill for year, they are subject to Scottish law not English law, the rules are entirely different. As far as we are concerned we have had a 10 point penalty, providing the CVA goes through we have exited the Administration the correct way there will be no further penalty, unless something comes out that we are not aware of where football rules are concerned I do not believe there will be any further action
- Q Geoff Wakefield, shareholder Would like clarification. At the time of the Jackson takeover on 29 December 2003 Grindeys were introduced as Peter Jackson's personal solicitors, the company that was created was an off the peg company of Grindeys, as Peter Jackson was on the board until June/July last year is this a possible conflict of interest?
- A RMY First of all Grindeys were my solicitors last time I was Administrator they were acting for me not Valiant 2001. I do believe the Valiant 2001 consortium did not have a company ready set up as the purchase vehicle and we allowed Grindeys to create that vehicle for them. I think Steve they had several lawyers didn't they?

Peter Jackson – If I might Bob, Jackson was never a member of Valiant 2001 despite the other directors who claimed to be founder members were never actually founder members of 2001 and the Jackson takeover came 8 months after club was sold to 2001

RMY – This was 9 years and it was me that brought Grindeys into the equation, as you know Grindeys they are a very good local firm. It may be that subsequently because they have done such a good job for me that Peter asked them to act for them but it has no bearing on today's

meeting A lot of businessmen use a lot of local lawyers. Peter Jackson I think did use George Green as well, I don't think it has any conflict and Grindeys in any event, in my experience, are totally professional enough not to allow conflicts of interest to arise.

- Q Anthony Cheetham, Shareholder A few years ago we were sponsored by Tricel and they did not pay their sponsorship. Tricel supplied PVFC with a number of shares on the understanding that they would keep those shares and not sell them until they had reached a certain figure on the New York stock exchange. Do you know anything about this, if you do not, will you find out, if you do, do you know if they have been sold or what has happened to them.
- A RMY I only know what I read in the press some years ago about that If any of you have any information that might assist I would be happy to look into that. My understanding is that yes the club entered into a contact with Tricel for sponsorship and Tricel subsequently failed. But if you think there was anything amiss we will add it to the list of things we have to investigate. If you have any knowledge or information that you can provide to us we will investigate if you wish.
- Q Jeff Kent, director, Witan Creations Wish to make 2 comments for the records, one re club and the former board of directors, and that is at the end of February the board signed two new players tried to sign a third one, Chris Birchall, failed to do that at a time when they owed thousands of pounds to creditors and I think it is absolutely scandalous that that happened The second thing is regarding the letters from the Administrators, I have 3 here, one is for Witan Creations, one is to Mr Jeff Kent and one is to Mr J Kent, what I am supposed to make of that I have not got a clue. I've got a degree from University of London and unfortunately the language that I speak is English and the language that, I'm afraid gentlemen, you've sent the correspondence in is legalise. I spent over 35 minutes on the phone with one of your colleagues the other day trying to get to the bottom of this. That 35 minutes is a phone bill to me and at 3p in the £ for the creditors obviously that is racking up more and more money. I am incidentally for the record voting for the acceptance of the 3p in the £ as I'm not prepared to vote to see the club close down but could you please take that point on board. Thank you
- A RMY Firstly apologies that we managed to write to you three times. The list of creditors we have been provided with has obviously got you down under different styles, but we have sent them to be conclusive and to make sure we have written to everybody. With regard to the legalise you are absolutely right, regrettably the insolvency act and the insolvency rules which states in this book (held up book) exactly how we have to send these notices out otherwise they are invalid. We tried to cover it off in the covering letter to make life a little bit easier and we have tried to make it easier today by running the Administration meeting, the CVA meeting and the shareholders meeting all as one rather than repeating ourselves three times. We are bound by the most ridiculous, complicated, convoluted statute law. It is the most verified area of statue law in the country, insolvency law, and regrettably we have to comply with it
- Q Brenda Stanway, Shareholder Your letter invited me here for 11 30, I was here for 11 15, the meeting had started, why did you start early without the people who are good enough to put money into your club. I arrived, I do not know who you are sitting up there because it all happened already without us and now you have said we are going vote on various things we were too late to hear most of it anyway, so why did you start.
- A GMK Let me answer the question by saying the shareholders meeting is the final meeting. There is an Administrators meeting at 10 30 and a CVA creditors meeting at 11 00 am.
- Q Brenda Shaw So are we going to have the shareholders meeting next then?
