The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting

#### 2. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from the Mayor of Felixstowe Cllr Jon Garfield, Therese Coffey MP. Cllr Graham Newman, Cllr Jan Garfield, Cllr Mike Deacon, Richard Kellar, Rosemery Fincham, Caroline Barrett and Colin Shaw

#### 3. Minutes of the Previous AGM

The minutes of the previous AGM held on  $6^{th}$  July 2009 were agreed and signed as a true record (Proposed by Bob Nice, seconded by Harry Riley)

#### 4. Chairman's Report

The Chairman gave the following report to the meeting

Facts was formed in 1991 to provide community transport for the people in Felixstowe and the Felixstowe peninsular who are in the need of such services because of age, sickness, disability, poverty or because of the lack of adequate public transport. In 2003 we also became a registered company so as to operate a

commercial Group Hire Service using our vehicle fleet to provide services to organisations, care facilities, schools and private functions

We are committed to operating our service to the highest standards of safety, reliability and care for both our users and volunteers

In May 2009 we took over the local Multiple Sclerosis Society's transport services for Felixstowe and their vehicle, a Ford Mini Bus. We now provide these services on behalf of the MS society. However the Ford has become too expensive to maintain

In July 2009 we implemented part of our strategy by donating our vehicle (VW) to Suffolk County Council (SCC) for the Dial-a Ride service

SCC in turn provided the vehicle back to us with all maintenance, fuel and tax paid by them

We also introduced an additional Dial-a-Ride service during the year, with the support of the SCC. This operates on Thursday am and Friday pm and relieves some of the pressure on typical shopping days. It has proved to be relatively successful

During 2009/2010 a business plan was produced for Suffolk County Council detailing the expected outturn for March 2011

Looking at our trading year for each of our services -

- The Dial-a-Ride service was affected by a slight down turn in usage in 2009. Our decision to use SCC-provided vehicles and the subsequent write down of our VW as an asset. We made a loss of £1200 before disposal and depreciation charges.
- The Community Car Service saw an increase in usage and this put pressure on our volunteers. From a financial prospective the Community Car Service has a zero impact on our finances providing it is administered efficiently, which again was the case, and credit must go to the staff and volunteers who operate the scheme
- Our Group Hire Service which is operated as stand alone commercial service produced a small operating deficit, which is disappointing

Although income was up 12%, expenses (salaries, NIC payments etc) increased by 21% and fuel increased by 20% to give an operating deficit of £483

We have been running our services at a level that is un-economic to sustain the Company's future

Accordingly we will press for an increase in Dial-a-Ride fares which have not risen since 2006 and we will also raise our Group Hire charges

The management team is committed to providing a solid foundation for the future so that our staff and volunteers can continue to provide our users with the excellent service that makes FACTS a great example of community support and cohesion

We are looking for additional people to be part of the Volunteer and Management Teams, so that FACTS can prosper for the benefit of Felixstowe and the local villages

#### 5. Consideration of Examined Accounts

The Chairman explained that the accounts had been prepared by the accountant, Angela Adams He then thanked the Independent Examiner, Tony Thurkettle, for examining the accounts and reporting that they were in good order

It was proposed by Helen Smith and seconded by David Crerar that the accounts together with the Trustees Annual Report be accepted This was agreed unanimously.

#### 6. Election of Directors

The following Directors were proposed by David Crerar and Doreen Savage and seconded by Doris Riley

Mr Gordon Stırrat, Dr Chris Wheddon, Mr Dennis Carpenter.

#### 7. Any Other Business

#### 7.1 Thanks from Deputy Mayor

Cllr Doreen Savage, the Deputy Mayor, thanked FACTS on behalf of the Town Council for all the valuable work which the organisation carries out. She hoped that FACTS would continue to provide an excellent service in the future. The Mayor's Consort, Peggy Osborne, also expressed her appreciation of the work carried out by FACTS and in particular the courteous and helpful attitude of the volunteers.

#### 7 2 Expansion of Activities

Trevor Lockwood asked about FACTS increasing its transport activities in the town, including applying for bus service contracts supported by the County Council The Chairman said that FACTS would continue to explore a range of new opportunities, but there was a need to ensure that any contracts entered into were financially viable for FACTS

#### 8. Date of Next AGM

It was agreed that this would be held near the end of June 2011

It is structured to provide various transport services for the benefit of those in Felixstowe and the Felixstowe Peninsular who are in need of such services because of age, sickness, disability, poverty or because of the lack of adequate public services

These services are provided under the working name of FACTS. The trustees/ directors who manage the charity are -Christopher Wheddon

Dennis Carpenter

NB Gordon Stirrat was a director and a trustee up until his death on 11 November 2010

Trustees are appointed in accordance with company articles

Representatives of staff, volunteers, users and our partners, Suffolk County

Council attend the quarterly management meetings

The Charity has enjoyed a better year financially than in 2010, posting a surplus over nearly £4000 after allowance for depreciation. This does include however a donation £ 2000 from the Suffolk Foundation to support the purchase of new Building for our volunteers which is scheduled for July 2011.

The Charity has performed well despite concerns with County Council funding and a challenging financial situation. The success of our operations is due to

our volunteers and staff and the Trustees would like to formally recognise the effort and time that all of the Facts community give so generously

The accounts show that provision has been made for some capital expenditure during 2011 and that adequate capital reserves remain for other necessary fixed assets

They have been independently examined in accordance with current company and charity legislation
