The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting

2. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from the Mayor of Felixstowe Cllr Angel Goodwin, Cllr Sandra Bryant, Cllr Sheila Wardner, Gordon Stirrat, Derek Cocker and Clive Rick

3. Minutes of the Previous AGM

The minutes of the previous AGM held on 30th June 2008 were agreed and signed as a true record (Proposed by Harry Riley, seconded by Richard Kellar)

4. Chairman's Report

The Chairman gave the following report to the meeting

"The objective of the company is to provide a community transport service for the inhabitants of the Felixstowe Peninsular and its neighbourhood. The service is strongly user focused and applies to those that need the service because of age, sickness, disability, poverty or because of the lack of adequate public passenger service.

"The company provides Dial-a-Ride and Community Car services with the support of, and in partnership with, Suffolk County Council We also operate a Group Hire service which is self financing These services are provided by about fifty-five volunteers and 3 part-time salaried staff

"The company has had a satisfactory trading year despite experiencing increased fuel, rent, energy and staff costs. Changes to our accounting policies in respect of our office assets have increased our depreciation charges. Overall we made a surplus of £10,749 before provision for depreciation and a loss of £2,618 after allowance for depreciation. The size of the loss partly reflects a change in accounting policies.

"FACTS provides an excellent service to its users through the efforts of our volunteers and staff. They have worked extremely hard this year and the Management Committee owes them a debt of gratitude

"The Dial a Ride service, which carries on average 650 passengers and covers 1600 miles per month, has been extended to provide extra service on Thursdays and Fridays. It made a very small loss this trading year. The Community Car service met its expected budget outturn, with the Group Hire service making a healthy surplus.

"I am pleased to report that we have received an acceptable draft lease from Suffolk Coastal District Council after 18 months of negotiation. We would not have achieved this without the assistance of Mike Deacon, the Mayor of Felixstowe

"Last year the Management Committee went through a major change with several Directors relinquishing their posts. We are looking therefore for suitable people to fill these positions, so far we have not been successful

"FACTS has a strong balance sheet However, increased costs experienced over past 12 months require close attention and the following are some of actions that the Management Committee will take -

- 1) One of our vehicles will be taken over by Suffolk County Council and provided back for us to operate,
- 2) Actively try to increase the number of volunteer drivers,
- 3) Generate new services i.e. increased Dial-a-Ride,
- 4) Reduce costs where we can,
- 5) Attend to the repair of the older Portakabin "

5. Consideration of Examined Accounts

The Chairman thanked the Independent Examiner, Tony Thurkettle, for examining the accounts and reporting that they were in good order

These services are provided under the working name of "FACTS"

Trustees are appointed in accordance with company articles. Representatives of staff, volunteers, users and our partners, Suffolk County Council attend the quarterly Management meetings.

The Charity has had a challenging year, our costs have risen beyond recompense from the fare income, we have also written down some assets which have impacted on our trading position.

Despite these financial concerns the Charity has performed to its own exacting standards, which is a credit to all at FACTS.

The accounts show that FACTS had a difficult business year, making a small profit before allowance for depreciation charges.
