1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The company has net current liabilities as at 31 May 2009 and is reliant on the ability of its directors to generate adequate revenue or funding. This creates an uncertainty over the use of the going concern basis in the preparation of the financial statements. However, the Directors consider that the company is in a strong position to secure service contract with large telecommunication organisation and that will enable the company to generate adequate revenue to ensure that the company is a going concern for at least twelve months from the date of signing of these financial statements.

After making enquiries and taking account of the factors noted above, the directors have a reasonable expectation that the company will have access to adequate resources to continue in existence for the foreseeable future. Accordingly, they continue to adopt the going concern basis in preparing the financial statements

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008)

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax
