1 Accounting policies

1 1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008)

1 2 Compliance with accounting standards

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated)

1 3 Turnover

Turnover comprises of income received from participation fees, ticket sales and other sundry activities in relation to the November 2011 show, exclusive of value added tax

1 4 Deferred Income and Expenditure

All Income received and expenditure incurred in the year in respect of the November 2012 Lord Mayor's Show have been carried forward and will be recognised in the year in which the show takes place
