

BASIS OF PREPARATION

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP), "Accounting and Reporting by Charities" issued in March 2005, applicable UK accounting standards and the Companies Act 2006.

Due to the reduction in Local Authority funding for the 2009/10 school academic year this policy, and the need for restructuring across the whole Parent Charity, future serviced income could not be guaranteed and the decision was made by the Trustees during the financial year 2009/10 for the Charity to cease trading As a result the Charity has been wound down and is now dormant. No statement of financial activities or income and expenditure account is therefore presented

FUND ACCOUNTING
