



Neither Director has a service contract, nor do they receive any emoluments from the Company.



### 1. PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following is a statement of the Principal Accounting Policies of the Company:

### 1.1 BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The Financial Statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards.

### 1.2 FRS 21 – EVENTS AFTER BALANCE SHEET DATE

During the year the company adopted FRS 21 Events after the balance sheet date which superseded SSAP17. Under the new standard, final dividends payable are recognised only in the period in which they are declared and therefore become a liability and interim dividends are recognised in the period in which they are paid, whereas under SSAP 17 dividends were accrued for when proposed.

### 1.3 FINANCIAL INSTRUMENT

Financial instruments are classified and accounted for, according to the substance of the contractual arrangement, as either financial assets, financial liabilities or equity instruments. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the company after deducting all of its liabilities.
