Accounting convention

Grant income

All grants are accounted for when receivable, as long as they are capable of financial measurement

Income is recognised as the company becomes entitled to the relevant income through performance or other criteria. Accordingly in the case of projects where income is based on expenditure incurred any excess of income received over expenditure is credited to deferred income within the balance sheet.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date

The net effect of the adjustments to the 31st March 2009 balance sheet was to increase creditors by £46,990 and increase debtors by £25 210. The net surplus for 2009 was reduced by £21,780.
