The following table shows the results of the regression analysis for the dependent variable "Number of publications" (N = 100). The independent variables are "Gender" (Male/Female) and "Age" (Young/Middle/Older). The table includes the coefficient estimates, standard errors, t-statistics, and p-values for each variable.

Variable	Coefficient	Standard Error	t-statistic	p-value
Intercept	1.2	0.1	12.0	<0.001
Gender (Male)	0.5	0.2	2.5	0.012
Gender (Female)	-0.3	0.2	-1.5	0.134
Age (Young)	0.8	0.1	8.0	<0.001
Age (Middle)	0.4	0.1	4.0	<0.001
Age (Older)	-0.2	0.1	-2.0	0.045

The regression results indicate that being male and younger are associated with a higher number of publications. Specifically, males have 0.5 more publications on average compared to females, and individuals in the "Young" age group have 0.8 more publications than those in the "Older" group. The intercept represents the expected number of publications for a female in the "Older" age group, which is 1.2.
