NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MAY 2016

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1a. Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

1b. Tangible fixed assets

Land and building are shown at original historical cost or subsequent valuation as set out in the note. Other fixed assets are shown at cost.

Depreciation is provided, after taking account of any grants receivable, at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machineryReducing balance 25%VehiclesReducing balance 25%Fixtures and fittingsReducing balance 15%EquipmentReducing balance 15%

1c. Stocks

Stocks are stated at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost incurred in bringing each product to its present location and condition is based on purchase cost on a first-in, first-out basis, including transport.

1d. Taxation

Corporation tax payable is provided on taxable profits at the current rate.

1e. Pensions

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme and the pension charge represents the amounts payable by the company to the fund in the year.

1f. Turnover

Turnover comprises the value of sales (excluding VAT and similar taxes and trade discounts) of goods and services in the normal course of business.

1g. Revaluation reserve

Revaluation deficits in excess of the amount of prior revaluation surpluses on the same asset are charged to the profit and loss account.
