'A' shares do not entitle the holders thereof to any rights to receive any dividends declared, or any distributions made, by the Company, and do not entitle the holders thereof to any rights to receive any capital beyond the normal value of 'A' shares on the winding up of the Company.

'B' shares entitle the holders to the right to receive all dividends declared, and distributions made, by the Company, and entitle the holders to the right to receive all capital on the winding up of the Company. enfranchisees and extended leaseholders in the building are issued with 'A' shares but only the original enfranchisees on the building's purchase on 26 July 2006 and their transferees are entitled to and issued with 'B' shares.

5. **POST BALANCE SHEET EVENTS**

After the year end, the company shared in a settlement from an insurance company in respect of a joint claim made by this company, Bryanston Court Management Company Limited and its subsidiary against individuals who held indemnity policies with that insurance company. This company's share of the proceeds is £154,440. The payment was made by way of settlement agreement, the terms of which are bound by confidentiality clauses.
