- 3.2 Cash at bank in the sum of £91,610 has been realised and an overdrawn directors loan account in the sum of £95,932 has been distributed in specie.
- 3.3 All known assets have now been realised.

4 Outcome for Creditors

- 4.1 Corporation tax in the total sum of £21,159 has been paid relating to the periods ended 31 March 2016 and 31 August 2015. Fees in the sum of £1,203 have been paid to Robinson + co, Chartered Accountants.

Appendix B

Additional Information in Relation to the Liquidators' Fees, Expenses & Disbursements

Staff Allocation and the Use of Sub-Contractors

The general approach to resourcing our assignments is to allocate staff with the skills and experience to meet the specific requirements of the case.

The constitution of the case team will usually consist of a Partner, a Manager, and an Administrator or Assistant. The exact constitution of the case team will depend on the anticipated size and complexity of the assignment and the experience requirements of the assignment.

We have not utilised the services of any sub-contractors or professional advisors in this case.

Liquidators' Expenses & Disbursements

The expenses (including disbursements) which were anticipated at the outset of the Liquidation was outlined to the members when the basis of my fees was approved.

Summary of Liquidators' expenses

A summary of the expenses paid by the Liquidator during the Period can be found in the Receipts and Payments account at Appendix A.

Category 1 disbursements do not require approval. The type of disbursements that may be charged as a Category 1 disbursement to a case generally comprise of external supplies of incidental services specifically identifiable to the case, such as postage, case advertising, invoiced travel and external printing, room hire and document storage. Also, chargeable will be any properly reimbursed expenses incurred by personnel in connection with the case.

Category 2 disbursements do require approval. These are costs which are directly referable to the appointment in question but are not payments which are made to an independent third party and may include shared or allocated costs that can be allocated to the appointment on a proper and reasonable basis such as internal room hire, document storage or business mileage. Details of Category 2 disbursements charged by this firm (where appropriate) were provided at the time the Liquidators' fees were approved by the members.
