Directors' Report

The Chairman presents his report for the year ended 31st March 2009.

The Trust has recently completed both the Heritage and the Shirehall Moor projects. The Heritage project has provided some nice historical interpretation for the benefit of visitors and locals alike. The Parade has been enhanced and could prove to be the catalyst for further improvements in this area. The educational element involving the local school children has proved a very worthwhile community programme. I thank Barbara Fraser and the Lostwithiel Museum The Town Council, having now taken over responsibility for Shirehall Moor, have applied for it to be designated as a Nature Reserve. It is hoped that Shirehall Moor will be listed in the next national publication of Nature Reserves.

The Historic Characterisation Study has been completed and presented to the public. This fine piece of work is most inspiring and I congratulate the team from County Hall for this and their great enthusiasm which was evident to all. We did allow for an extra 20 copies on our initial print run. These have all been sold. If there is a demand we will consider printing more.

After two years of assisting the Hannah Reynolds Organisation and The Princes' Regeneration Trust in feasibility studies we are pleased to have identified the Lostwithiel Town Band as an ideal short term tenant of the Duchy Palace prior to its refurbishment. The Princes' Regeneration Trust has subsequently completed the purchase of the Palace and the band are taking up the offer of a short

We have several possible future projects for consideration and will need to select and proceed without much delay in order to maintain an income stream. We do not possess any community assets as yet, but to be a successful development trust must seriously consider this situation.

We have settled in well at our new head quarters, the Platform. The station waiting room is now open 6 days a week, thanks to a reliable group of volunteers who open and close the facility.
