Intercompany debtor

The declaration of solvency, sworn by the directors prior to the commencement of the liquidation, showed a debt of £2 due from Spire Healthcare Limited ('SHL') (the 'Debt'). The Debt will be distributed in specie to the shareholder prior to the conclusion of the liquidation.

Fylde Coast Hospital, Clare Park Hospital and Bath Road Surgery & Premises (the '**Properties**')

Various notices have been received from Blackpool Council, Reading Borough Council and District Hart Council in respect of business rates relating to the Properties. These show a net refund due.

The Properties were previously leased to the Company. However, in 2016, as part of the hive up of the Company's business and assets to SHL, the relevant leases were Classic Hospitals Limited - in Members' Voluntary Liquidation Joint Liquidators' annual progress report for the period from 16 September 2021 to 15 September 2022

assigned to SHL. Any outstanding business rates refunds are therefore an asset of SHL, not the Company.

Given that SHL has been the lessee of the Properties since 2016, we have asked SHL to liaise with the relevant councils to change the name on their accounts accordingly. We are awaiting confirmation that the accounts have been updated.

Creditors

The Company had no known creditors at the date of liquidation.

A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidation was advertised in the London Gazette on 29 September 2021 and the Metro on 7 October 2021.

The only claim received in the Company's liquidation to date is a claim of £469.45 from Merchant Rentals Limited. The Joint Liquidators are awaiting information from Spire Healthcare to enable them to adjudicate the claim.

Tax

All pre-liquidation corporation tax matters were handled in-house by Spire Healthcare who prepared and submitted all outstanding returns up to the date of the commencement of the liquidation to HM Revenue & Customs ('HMRC'). The Joint Liquidators have requested, and are awaiting, confirmation from HMRC that the Company has no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that it will not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it has no objection to the Joint Liquidators taking steps to bring the liquidation to a conclusion.

The Joint Liquidators have sought, and are awaiting, similar assurances from HMRC in respect of PAYE and VAT matters.

Distributions

There were no distributions during the year.

Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses

A written resolution was passed on 16 September 2021 that the remuneration of the Joint Liquidators be fixed in accordance with the Interpath Ltd engagement letter dated 10 June 2021.

During the year, the Joint Liquidators' remuneration and expenses totalling £37,960 were paid by another group company, Spire Healthcare Finance Limited. These fees related to pre-appointment advisory work in respect of the Company and 12 other companies also placed into members' voluntary liquidation on 16 September 2021 (together, the 'Companies').

In accordance with Rules 18.9 and 18.34 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016, members may request further information about the remuneration and expenses of the Joint Liquidators of the Companies or apply to court to challenge the
