FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves

There was a deficit of £7,197 in the year after administrative expenses of £99,807. The balance of un-restricted funds to carry forward is £65,11½ leaves the charity in a reasonably strong position going forward especially with the increasing pressure on funding from local authorities.
