OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The trustees have considered the Charity Commision's guidance on public benefit, including the guidance 'public benefit: running a charity (PB2)'.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves

There was a surplus of £20,435 in the year after administrative expenses of £104,396. The balance of un-restricted funds to carry forward is £8. This leaves the charity in a reasonably strong position going forward especially with the increasing pressure on funding from local authorities.

The Charity is governed by the Memorandum and Articles of Association of Wyre Forest Dial-a-Ride, a company limited by guarantee under the Companies Act 2006.
