1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Status of the company

The National Federation of Badger Groups was incorporated as a company limited by guarantee and not having any share capital

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Companies Act 1985, Charities Act 1993, Statement of Recommended Practice 2005 'Accounting & Reporting by Charities' and the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2005)

The company was dormant throughout the period ended 31st December 2005

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life

Fixtures and fittings

- 20% on reducing balance

Computer equipment

- 20% on reducing balance

Tangible fixed assets are included at cost

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is provided on the liability method to take account of timing differences between the treatment of certain items for accounts purposes and their treatment for tax purposes. Tax deferred is accounted for in respect of all material timing differences. The company has not adopted a policy of discounting deferred tax assets and liabilities.

Pensions

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable for the year are charged in the profit and loss account
