The Trustee Directors present their report and financial statements for the year ended 31st March 2020.

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the accounting policies set out in note 1 to the accounts and comply with the charitable company's Memorandum and Articles of Association, the Companies Act 2006 and the Statement of Recommended Practice, "Accounting and Reporting by Charities".

1. Objectives and Activities

The principal objectives of the charity are to provide or assist in the provision of facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation or other leisure time, occupation of individuals who have need to such facilities by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disability, financial hardship or social circumstances with the objective of improving their conditions of life.

The charity provides gym facilities at The Wensleydale Centre and arranges associated activities, which is how the charity's activities deliver a public benefit. The charity registration number is 1126795 and the company number is 05493687.

2. Governing Document

The Charity is governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association and is limited by Guarantee. As a not for profit organisation, the company does not have the powers to pay a dividend.

3. Trustee Directors

4. The company is limited by guarantee and does not have any share capital.

5. Management and Governance Arrangements

The Charity and its property is administered and managed by the Trustees.

Where there is a requirement for an individual to be appointed as a Trustee, suitable people are identified by the existing Trustees and are then invited to take up the role.

The Trustees are responsible for reviewing and identifying risks that the charity faces to enable them to protect the assets of the charity.

The Trustees plan to undertake a Governance review in the year ahead.

6. Results for the year and Financial Review

The Trustees present the accounts for the year ended 31st March 2020. At the 31st March 2020, the general reserves stood at (£996), (2019: (£1,327)), and restricted reserves amounted to £75,000 (2019: £83,439). Income generated from activities increased from £21,384 in 2019 to £26,896 in 2020.

7. Achievements and Performance

During the year the charity continued working hard to promote and manage the facilities. An enthusiastic Manager and volunteer group continue to expand the activities to the wider community.

The Trustees continue to look at new ways of connecting the charity with the community, to promote the charity and support certain groups within the community who would benefit socially and physically from being associated with the charity.

There has been increased use of the facilities for community based learning activities, fitness classes and room hire. We have also been successful with grant applications and fundraising activities. The community continues to engage with us and support the running and development of the centre.

Trustees' Responsibilities

The trustees are responsible for preparing the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and regulations.

Charity and company law requires the directors to prepare financial statements for each financial year. Under that law the trustees have elected to prepare the financial statements in accordance with United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice (United Kingdom Accounting Standards and applicable law). The financial statements are required by law to give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the charity and of the surplus or deficit of the charity for that period. In preparing those financial statements, the trustees are required to:

- Observe the methods and principles of Charities SORP;
- Select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- Make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- Prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the charity will continue in business;
- State whether applicable accounting standards and statements of recommended practice have been followed, subject to any departures disclosed and explained in the financial statements.

The trustees are responsible for keeping proper accounting records that disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the charity and enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Charities Act, the Charity (Accounts and Reports) Regulations 2008 and the Companies Act 2006. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

The Trustees consider that they have complied with the duty in Section 17 (5) of the 2011 Charities Act to have due regard to guidance issued on public benefit.

1 Accounting Policies

1.1 Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Accounting and Reporting by charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective January 2015) – (charities SORP (FRS 102)), the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) and the Companies Act 2006. In preparing the accounts, the trustees have considered whether in applying the accounting policies required by FRS 102 and the Charities SORP FRS 102 the restatement of comparative items was required. There were no adjustments on transition to FRS 102.

1.2 Incoming Resources

Income represents amounts generated from recreational activities, grants and donations. Income from government and other grants, whether 'capital' grants or 'revenue' grants, is recognised when the association has entitlements to the funds, any performance conditions attached to the grants have been met, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably and is not deferred. Unrestricted funds are available to spend on activities that further any of the purposes of association

1.3 Tangible Fixed Assets and Depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:
