#### Review of the year

Significant progress was made on a number of the Economy projects during the year, not least the opening the Partnership Community Shop (Billingshurst Creatives) in September 2012 (See Notes on Page 13)

An Information Centre located in the library will be opened later this year and a Retailer Group has now been established. An Event Board is now located in Jengers Mead and Notice Boards Located in Jengers Passage and in Jengers Mead.

The Yes Project is still going strong and is being developed further to provide training for Young People on CV Writing and Interview techniques. The Eye project has stalled at present because of issues regarding site availability. Currently work is being carried out to establish a vitual EYE an online Youth Club which it is hoped will go live later this year.

The Lunch Club continues to be held each fortnight at the village hallseveral new members joined and Ejoyed a varied programme which include outings for lunch and tea

Billifest 2012 the Christmas Market supported by the Parish and District Councils and many local traders and organisations was held in December and was a great success on the day

#### Fixed assets

#### Reserves policy

The company's primary objective is undertaking projects that will provided services or amenities for the local community. No commitments are made to those individual projects until the funding required is secured and then the project is carried out to an agreed budget within the funds available.

The general administration of the company is primarily funded through a variety of grants secured from Public Bodies. The boards intention is to ensure that the general reserve is sufficient to finance the following years running costs.

**Community Shop** 

Billingshurst Creatives a Non Profit Shop was opened in September 2012 and is intended to give an opportunity to small arts/craft traders an opportunity to show and sell their wares with a low outlay. In addition it is hoped that the presence of the shop will increase the retail footfall within the village.

The shop was set up with the aid of grants from Horsham DC and West Sussex CC (Enterprise Grant) The grants are intended to cover the costs of setting up and running the shop for the first year. The first year rents collected from traders are then intended to cover the running costs inyear two. Year two rents will cover

the rents inyear three and so on
