The year saw the completio of the Sustainable Communities Project from which 5 further projects have been identified. These projects (Shop Local, Parking & Transport, PR & Marketing, a Partnersip Shop and Retail Support.) will be taken forward 2010/11 as part of the Village Regeneration project.

A Multi Court and Youth Shelter was installed in Station Road and the weekly youth drop-in TAG continues to attract up to 40 young people The Youth Enterprise Scheme offering part-time work opportunities continues to go well and will be expanded later in 2010. The EU project in partnership with a group from Ireland aiming to raise awareness of differences between EU member states has secred funding and will begin in September 2010.

The Lunch Club continues to be held each fortnight although attracting people continues to present a challenge

Billifest 2009 supported both by the Parish and Distict Councils was a great success on the day
