Signicant progress has been made on the EYE project. A planning application has been submitted and it is hoped that approval will be forthcoming early in the new year.

The Lunch club, held every fortnight continues to be a great success. Several new members have joined and there is a varied programme of speakers and activities.

Billifest 2015, the Community Event and Christmas Market supported by the County Council, District Council, Local Organisation, Local Traders, Developers and the local community was held in December. The day was very successful with the addition of a number of new traders and activities for Children.
