Review of the year

The Partnership Community Shop (Billingshurst Creatives) has had a good 18 months since opening in September 2012. Several traders moved on after the initial 12 months with new ones taking their place. Rental income has not yet reached its maximum but the amount in hand will cover running costs until March 2015.

The Yes Project is still going strong and is being developed further to provide a passport for Young People showing their work experience. This initiative is being supported by both local businesses and local authorities.

Progress has been made on the Eye project with a new site identified. The project is now being worked up by the Project Team.

The Lunch Club continues to be held each fortnight at the village hall several new members have joined and enjoyed a varied programme which include outings for lunch and tea.

Billifest 2013 the Christmas Market supported by the District Council and many local traders and organisations was held in December. The day was a great success with anumber of new traders and attractions particularly for children.

Results for the year

Details of the results for the year are set out in the statement of financial activities on pages 5-12.

Fixed assets

The company has no fixed assets.

Reserves policy

The company's primary objective is undertaking projects that will provided services or amenities for the local community. No commitments are made to those individual projects until the funding required is secured and then the project is carried out to an agreed budget within the funds available.

The general administration of the company is primarily funded through a variety of grants secured from Public Bodies. The boards intention is to ensure that the general reserve is sufficient to finance the following years running costs.

Taxation status

In the opinion of the directors the company is exempt from taxation in respect of its income.

Investment policy

The directors do not consider it prudent to invest in anything other than very low risk investments. Cash required for operational purposes is held in an ordinary bank current account.

Small company exemptions

Community Shop

Billingshurst Creatives a Non Profit Shop was opened in September 2012 and is intended to give an opportunity to small arts/craft traders an opportunity to show and sell their wares with a low outlay. In addition it is hoped that the

presence of the shop will increase the retail footfall witin the village.

The shop was set up with the aid of grants from Horsham DC and West Sussex CC (Enterprise Grant). The grants are intended to cover the costs of setting up and running the shop for the first year. The first year rents collected from traders are then intended to cover the running costs in year two. Year two rents will cover

the rents in year three and so on.
