# Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year Ended 31 October 2014

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### Going concern

At the balance sheet date, Kristos Media has net current liabilities of £125,166. The company is dependent on the continuing financial support of Mr Alan Dargan for the continuation of its activities. He has provided formal confirmation to the company that he will not request repayment of his loan for a period of at least 12 months from the date of signing these accounts. Based on this, the accounts have been prepared on a going concern basis.

#### Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, with the exception of investments which are included at market value, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008), the Companies Act 2006 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities.

### Preparation of consolidated financial statements

The financial statements contain information about Kristos Media as an individual charity and do not contain consolidated financial information as the parent of a group. The charity has taken the option under Section 398 of the Companies Act 2006 not to prepare consolidated financial statements.

### **Incoming resources**

All income is recognised in the statement of financial activities on a receipts basis.

#### Resources expended

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

### Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

### Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
