1 - INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. Following the appointment of Nigel Morrison and myself as joint administrators of the Group by the directors on 10 October 2008, I am submitting my proposals pursuant to paragraph 49(1) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 for achieving the objectives of the administrations.
- 1.2. This report contains the information required by Rule 2.33 of the Insolvency Rules 1986.
- 1.3. In accordance with paragraph 100 (2) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 the functions of the administrators are to be exercised by any or all of them.

2 STATUTORY INFORMATION

- 2.1. The Group's statutory details are attached at Appendix A.
- 2.2. The administrations constitute "main proceedings" under the EC Regulation on Insolvency Proceedings.

3 BACKGROUND TO ADMINISTRATORS' APPOINTMENT

- 3.1. Grant Thornton UK LLP (the firm) was first consulted by Barclays Bank Plc (the Bank), which holds qualifying floating charges over the assets of both Sterlings D.F.C. Limited and RVS Insulation Services Limited dated 6 May 2003 and 17 March 2006 respectively, on 31 January 2008 with a view to giving advice on the Group's financial affairs and the Bank's future policy towards the Group.
- 3.2. Prior to that consultation, neither I nor the firm, had any dealings or involvement with the Group, the directors or its secretaries.
- 3.3. The firm carried out a brief investigation into the Group's financial position and produced a letter of advice to the Bank dated 17 March 2008. The conclusions and recommendations in respect of the financial position of the Group can be summarised as follows:
 - The Group was insolvent on a balance sheet and cashflow basis.

 Several directors had been involved with the Group for over 30 years and had injected significant personal funds into the business. In the absence of these funds the business would have been unable to trade over the last year.
 - ii In the year ended 31 April 2007, the Group generated a loss of £478,000 and had forecast a loss of £182,000 for the year ending 31 April 2008. As a result the Group attempted to secure additional funding from the Bank.
 - The Group operated a dividend scheme to pay employees which necessitated the creation of the related companies, this significantly reduced employment costs, however it was unclear how sustainable the scheme would be given that recent legislation has changed to make similar schemes unworkable. Should this have occurred, the Group's liabilities would have increased by £180,000.
 - iv Whilst the Group's cashflow forecasts showed a reduced loss in 2008 and a move to profitability in 2009, the Group's cashflow forecasts depended upon peak funding requirements of £739,000 in March 2008 and £793,000 in March 2009, associated with the payment of Corporation Tax and VAT quarters.
- 3.4. The firm was also engaged by the Group's directors on 22 August 2008 to assist the Group in its efforts to refinance the business. Despite contacting several potential sources of funding, in view of the financial position above, no additional funds were raised.
- 3.5. The firm was subsequently instructed by the Group on 25 September 2008 to assist in placing the Group into administration and to determine whether a sale could be achieved.
- 3.6. The purpose of our assistance was to enable management to fulfil its obligations to act in creditors best interests, given it had recognised and

acknowledged that the Group was insolvent. A summary of the Group's position at this time is as follows:

- i The Bank had capped the Group's overdraft facility at £420,000. The overdraft at this time was circa £402,000.
- ii Other Bank loans totalled circa £245,000 although it was estimated that approximately £103,000 would be recoverable under the Small Firms Loan Guarantee Scheme (SFLGS).
- iii Barclays Sales Finance (BSF) had limited its CID facility to 80% of allowable book debts. Funds in use at this time amounted to circa £400,000.
- iv Total Bank exposure including BSF, net of any recovery from SFLGS, was circa £944,000.
- v The Bank had informed the Group that it intended to withdraw its facilities by 1 October 2008. However, this time frame was temporarily delayed to allow for negotiations with interested parties to continue to enable a going concern sale of the business and assets to be achieved.
- vi The Group was no longer able to manage within its existing overdraft facility and was facing formal insolvency.
- vii Trade creditors were in excess of £340,000 and circa £190,000 was due to H M Revenue and Customs.
- viii The directors believed that they would be able to continue to trade if the overdraft facility was increased by a further £150,000 to £200,000 beyond its existing facility.
- ix The directors had consulted all parties known to them who may have an interest in purchasing the business on a going concern basis although no interest was generated in this regard.
- 3.7. Having considered all the options the directors considered that the best route for the Group was for it to be placed into administration and subsequently, on 10 October 2008 made the direct appointment of administrators in accordance with paragraph 22 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986.
- 3.8. The objective of the administrations were to achieve a better result for the Group's creditors as a whole than would be likely if the Group were wound up.

4 CONDUCT OF THE ADMINISTRATION

- 4.1. The Group undertook a variety of work, including transport refrigeration services, transport repair, tail-lift and shutter services, commercial body repair, commercial refrigeration services and MOT and domestic vehicle services.
- 4.2. The Group's main location was its freehold workshop and offices at Tongwynlais, Cardiff.

Sale of Business

- 4.3. Having actively marketed the business prior to appointment, an offer to acquire the business and assets was received and was accepted immediately following formal insolvency.
- 4.4. Following recommendations from GVA and Go Industry, the freehold property was sold for £475,000 and the floating charge assets were sold for £5,000.

5 ASSETS AND LIABILITIES

- 5.1. The directors have been requested to prepare a statement of affairs for the Group; I have been informed that they are currently working on producing this information which will be submitted to me in due course.
- 5.2. I attach in Appendix B, a list of the names and addresses of the creditors, the amounts of their debts and the details of any security held.

Secured Creditors

- 5.3. At the date of appointment the Bank was owed circa £636,000 and held a debenture dated 6 May 2003 and a fixed charge over the freehold property dated 10 June 2003. In view of the level of realisations the Bank will not recover its lending in full.
- 5.4. BSF had entered into a Sales Ledger Financing Agreement with Sterlings DFC Limited on 24 October 2003 and was owed circa £400,000 on appointment. BSF has outsourced the collection of book debts following appointment and it is unlikely that there will be surplus funds available at the conclusion of the collection process.

Preferential Creditors

5.5. The level of preferential creditors has not been calculated at this stage, however, there is no prospect of funds becoming available to meet these claims.

Unsecured Creditors

5.6. There will be no funds available to meet the claims of unsecured creditors.

6 PROPOSALS FOR ACHIEVING THE OBJECTIVE OF THE ADMINISTRATION

- 6.1. The administrators have pursued the objective of achieving a better result for the Group's creditors as a whole than would have been likely if the Group was wound up.
- 6.2. As detailed earlier in this report, the administrators have sold the business and assets as a going concern in order to enable for a distribution to be made to the secured creditors.
- 6.3. It is proposed that the administrations will end by the Group going into creditors voluntary liquidation, or if there are no monies available for unsecured creditors, by the dissolution of the Group. If the Group is placed into creditors voluntary liquidation it is proposed that Alistair Wardell and Nigel Morrison will be appointed as liquidators. However, creditors may nominate a different liquidator providing nomination to that effect is received before the approval of these proposals.

7 ADMINISTRATORS' REMUNERATION AND DISBURSEMENTS

- 7.1. To date, I have not drawn any fees on account. As there is no dividend prospects for unsecured creditors payment of fees is subject to the agreement of the secured and preferential creditors.
- 7.2. Background information regarding the fees of administrators can be found at http://www.insolvency-practitioners.org.uk (navigate via 'Technical' to 'Creditors Guides to Fees'). Alternatively I will supply this information by post on request.
- 7.3. The administrators will request that their remuneration be calculated according to the time properly given by the administrators and their staff in attending to matters arising in the administrations.
- 7.4. The administrator will charge out of pocket expenses at cost. Mileage is charged at standard rates which comply with HM Revenue and Customs limits or AA recommended rates. VAT is added to disbursement charges as necessary.
- 7.5. Payments of the administrators' remuneration and disbursements are to be met from funds held in the administration in priority to the claims of creditors, and, after approval of the basis, the administrator may draw sums on account.
- 7.6. Time costs to date amount to £41,436, representing 176 hours at an average of £235 per hour. Further details, including a breakdown by category of staff and work done will be given to the creditors' committee, if appointed, or made available at the creditors' meeting.

8 MEETING OF CREDITORS

- 8.1. A meeting of creditors has not been convened in accordance with paragraph 52 (1) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986, as I am of the opinion that the Group have insufficient assets to enable a distribution to be made to unsecured creditors.
- 8.2. The proposals contained in this statement will be deemed to have been approved by the creditors unless, within 12 days of this statement being sent out, a meeting is requisitioned by creditors whose debts amount to at least 10% by value of the total debts of that company.
