Executive Committee Report

In 2006/7 our main focus has been the economic regeneration of Hillsborough through the work of the Town Centre Development Worker HONF has tackled a wide range of issues the weir clean up, fly tipping, graffiti, CCTV, the Retail Radio Scheme, parking, Hillsborough corner, Pub licensing hours, the variety of shops, shop opening hours and empty shops. We also shouldn't forget the floral displays which have made such a difference to the appearance of Hillsborough.

Over the last year perhaps our main achievement has been the development of the Strategy for Hillsborough Town Centre, developing ideas for the economic regeneration of the area, ready with a plan of action as and when funding becomes available. At present we are working to get the plan adopted as part of the Sheffield Development Framework. The Strategy is available to view at the local library or can be downloaded it from our website (honf btik com).

Our other achievements include the production of a leaflet for Hillsborough outlining the shopping opportunities in Hillsborough and the maps of the area now displayed in Hillsborough

We work in conjunction with other local organisations, both voluntary and statutory, including the Retail Association, Pub Watch, the Hillsborough Residents Association, Hillsborough Park Regeneration Steering Group and the North West Regeneration Partnership amongst others We also have good relations with Sheffield City Council, mainly through the Area Panel We have supported a number of local events including the Hillsborough Park Summer and Xmas festivals, Pink Hillsborough and the Parson Cross and Burton Street festivals

There are of course many remaining issues to be dealt with, particularly in the area of the community development aspect of our work, in which we haven't made as much progress as we would have liked. We do however maintain contact with many local organisations and projects and presently are working to produce a Community Directory to help keep local people in touch with what is going on in the area. We intend to develop a strategy for Community Development similar to that for the Town Centre
