**UPON THE APPLICATION** of James Patrick Nicholas Martin dated [ ]

**AND UPON READING** the witness statement of James Patrick Nicholas Martin filed in support thereof

**AND UPON READING** the written consent of the First and Third Respondents to the terms of this Order

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The County Court case listed in the Schedule 2 (attached to this order) be transferred to the High Court of Justice solely for the purpose of considering, and, if thought fit, making the orders listed below.
2. Immediately upon this order taking effect, the County Court case listed in Schedule 2 (attached to this order) be transferred back to the County Court.

3. The Applicant does ensure that a sealed copy of every order transferring any case to this Court and of every order which may be made as a result of this application be lodged with the Court having jurisdiction over each case affected by such order.
4. The Applicant be removed from office in respect of each of the cases listed in Schedules 1 and 2 (attached to this order) from the date of this order.
5. The Third Respondent be appointed as joint replacement officeholder in respect of each of the block transfer cases listed in Schedule 1 (attached to this order) with effect from the date of this order.
6. The First Respondent be appointed as replacement officeholder in respect of block transfer cases 1 and 2 listed in Schedule 2 (attached to this order) with effect from the date of this order.
7. The First Respondent be appointed as joint replacement officeholder in respect of block transfer case 3 listed in Schedule 2 (attached to this order) with effect from the date of this order.
8. Notwithstanding the removal of the Applicant from the office of administrator, any progress reports that are filed pursuant to Rule 18.6(1) will continue to cover the period that applied prior to the making of this order and for the avoidance of doubt Rule 18.6(2) shall apply in respect of the administration listed in Schedule 1 (attached to this order).
9. *Notwithstanding the removal of the Applicant from the office of liquidator, any progress reports that are filed pursuant to Rule 18.8(5) will continue to cover the period that applied prior to making this order and for the avoidance of doubt Rule 18.8(2) shall apply in respect of the liquidations listed in Schedule 1 (attached to this order).*
10. Notwithstanding the removal of the Applicant from the office of trustee in bankruptcy, any progress reports that are delivered pursuant to Rule 18.8(6) will continue to cover the period that applied prior to making this order and for the avoidance of doubt Rule 18.8(2) shall apply in respect of the bankruptcies listed in Schedule 2 (attached to this order).
11. In respect of the administration listed in Schedule 1 (attached to this order), pursuant to Rule 18.6(3), the Third Respondent shall as soon as reasonably practicable after this Order is made, deliver a notice to the creditors of any matters about which he thinks the creditors should be informed.
12. In respect of the liquidations listed in Schedule 1 (attached to this order), pursuant to Rule 18.8(3), the Third Respondent shall as soon as reasonably practicable after this Order is made, deliver a notice to the creditors of any matters about which he thinks the creditors should be informed.

13. In respect of the bankruptcies listed in Schedule 2, pursuant to Rule 18.8(3), the First Respondent shall as soon as reasonably practicable after this Order is made, deliver a notice to the creditors of any matters about which he thinks the creditors should be informed.
14. Insofar as he is removed from the office of administrator by this Order, the Applicant is discharged from liabilities with effect from the date of this order, pursuant to paragraph 98(2)(c) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986.
15. Nothing in this order shall release the outgoing officeholder from any obligation to give and file notices in respect of his removal under this order in respect of the block transfer cases listed in *Schedules*.
16. The replacement officeholders shall give notice to the Secretary of State of the terms of this order as soon as reasonably practicable.
17. In respect of the liquidations and administration listed in Schedule 1 (attached to this order), the replacement officeholder shall give notice to the Registrar of Companies of the terms of this order as soon as reasonably practicable.
18. The creditors in each of the block transfer cases listed in the Schedules shall be notified of this order by advertisement in the London Gazette within 28 days of the date of this order and, additionally, at the time of the next statutory reporting requirement for each case.
19. Any creditor, or in the case of any members' voluntary liquidation, any member, in respect of any of the companies or persons listed in the Schedules (attached to this order) who has an objection to this order shall have 28 days from the date of the advertisement in the London Gazette, to apply to court to set aside or vary the terms of this order. Such application shall not affect the transfer of the block transfer cases listed in the Schedules until a further or other order by the court.
