UK Branch (the "Bank"), pursuant to which the Company will guarantee payment, subject to a maximum aggregate liability of £25,000, to the Bank of any shortfall in the payment of interest by Oakapple (Aire Valley) Limited ("O(AV)L") to the Bank pursuant to the terms of a facility letter dated 17 January 2007 (the "Facility Letter") between the Bank, O(AV)L, the Company and Oakapple Partnerships Limited (in their capacities as guarantors) in connection with the acquisition by O(AV)L of the Property (as defined in the Facility Letter) and the acquisition and development of part of the Property is hereby approved.
