NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 23 FEBRUARY 2013

1. PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements are prepared on the going concern basis in accordance with applicable accounting standards, under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Companies Act 2006. These have been applied consistently during the period.

The Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Tesco Blue (GP) Limited and is included in the consolidated financial statements of Tesco Blue (GP) Limited, which are publicly available. Consequently, the Company has taken advantage of the exemption from preparing a cash flow statement under the terms of FRS 1 "Cash Flow Statements".

2. ACTIVITY AND DIRECTORS

During the year the Company has not traded and consequently a Profit and Loss Account has not been disclosed.

The Directors received no emoluments for their services to the Company (2012: £nil).

4. ULTIMATE PARENT UNDERTAKING

The Company's immediate parent undertaking is Tesco Blue (Nominee Holdco) Limited, which in turn is owned by Tesco Blue (GP) Limited. Tesco Blue (GP) Limited is jointly owned by Tesco Property Holdings (No 2) Limited and Tesco Pension Trustees Limited. Tesco Pension Trustees Limited purchased the shares in Tesco Blue (GP) Limited on behalf of the Tesco PLC Pension Scheme (the "Scheme") and is required to act in the best interests of the Scheme.

The Company's ultimate parent undertaking is Tesco PLC which is registered in England and Wales and which is the parent undertaking of the smallest and largest group to consolidate these financial statements.
