WRITTEN RESOLUTION

Pursuant to Chapter 2 of Part 13 of the Companies Act 2006 (the “**Act**”), the directors of the Company propose that the following resolution be passed as a special resolution (the “**Resolution**”):

SPECIAL RESOLUTION

1. "THAT, pursuant to section 641(1)(a) of the Act, the capital of the Company be reduced from £500,001 to £50 by:
- (a) by reducing the nominal value of 255,000 A ordinary shares with a nominal value of £1.00 each, 245,000 B ordinary shares with a nominal value of £1.00 each and 1 C ordinary share with a nominal value of £1.00 to 255,000 A ordinary shares with a nominal value of £0.0001 each, 245,000 B ordinary shares with a nominal value of £0.0001 each and 1 C ordinary share with nominal value of £0.0001 respectively


(together, the “**Capital Reduction**”) and that £499,951 arising upon the Capital Reduction be credited to the Company’s retained earnings.”

If you agree to the Resolution, please ensure that your agreement reaches us before the end of this period.
