#### Structure, governance and management

The company is registered as a private company limited by guarantee and not having a share capital

The subscribers to the memorandum are the first members of the Charity but membership is open to other individuals or organisations who apply to the Charity and are approved by the directors

Under charity law those persons having the general control and management of the administration of the Charity are deemed to be charity trustees

#### Objectives and activities

The company operates as a charity to provide housing and support to disadvantaged members of the community.

Achievements and performance

Over the last year, the company has expanded greatly from 6 hostels to 11 hostels, 5 female and 6 male hostels. The company has also facilitated the "move on programmes" for about 20 of their clients who have moved on from the hostels to independent living. The company has also recruited more staff in the last year.

#### Financial review

Throughcare continues to source for funds for its charitable activities from various funding bodies.

Plans for future periods

Througeare plans to move office and open a resource centre to train more clients and staff and also commence our apprenticeship programme in the next financial year. Throughcare also plans to expand the current 24hour hostels to at least 3 by the end of the year.

Responsibilities of the trustees

The trustees (one of whom is also the director of Throughcare Housing & Support Ltd for the purposes of company law) are responsible for preparing the Trustees Annual Report and the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice)

Company law requires the trustees to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the charitable company and of the incoming resources and application of resources, including the income and expenditure, of the charitable company for that period. In preparing these financial statements, the trustees are required to
