Order

UPON THE APPLICATION by CPR Part 8 Claim Form by the Claimants dated 6 October 2020

AND UPON READING THE EVIDENCE AND UPON READING the letter of no objection dated 21 May 2020 from the Defendant

AND THE COURT being satisfied that the misstatement that the charges are satisfied was accidental or due to inadvertence and that it is just and equitable that the misstatement be rectified pursuant to Section 859M of the Act



AND THE COURT being satisfied that the information on the register is factually inaccurate, that the presence of the material on the register may cause damage to the claimant companies and that the claimants' interest in removing the material outweigh any interest of other persons in the material continuing to appear on the register pursuant to Section 1096 of the Act

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. pursuant to section 1096 of the Companies Act 2006 the Defendant do remove from the charges register and filing history of each of the Claimants the notification of a full release of a charge (Form MR04) filed on 09 January 2020 registered against charge codes, 0594 9301 0009 for the First Claimant, 0599 4595 0005 for the Second Claimant, 0599 5374 0005 for the Third Claimant and 0603 3691 0001 for the Fourth Claimant;
2. pursuant to section 859M of the Companies Act 2006, the Defendant do remove from the charges register of each Claimant the statement recording the charges with charge codes, 0594 9301 0009 for the First Claimant, 0599 4595 0005 for the Second Claimant, 0599 5374 0005 for the Third Claimant and 0603 3691 0001 for the Fourth Claimant as satisfied and replace it with the word "outstanding";
3. the Claimants do deliver a Copy of this Order to the Defendant; and
4. No order as to costs
