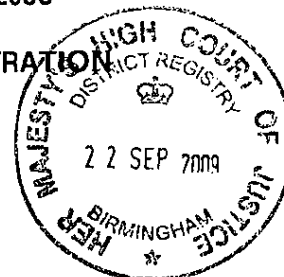

**Upon reading an undated application by the administrators supported by a witness statement dated 16 September 2009 by Ian James Gould**

**And upon reading the report of the administrators dated 16 September 2009**

**And upon the court deciding to determine the application without a hearing**

**It is ordered that**

- (1) The administration be extended until Noon on 9 October 2010 pursuant to paragraph 76(2)(a) of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986.**
- (2) The requirement for the Administrators to prepare and distribute a report to creditors for the six-month period ending 9 October 2009 be dispensed with, subject to the progress report dated 16 September 2009 prepared pursuant to rule 2.112 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 (referred to hereinafter as "the Rules") being distributed pursuant to rule 2.47(4) of the Rules.**
- (3) The Administrators' progress report in respect of the period ending 9 April 2010 shall include information relating to the administration between 15 September 2009 and 10 October 2009.**
- (4) The costs of this application shall be treated as an expense of the administration.**
- (5) This order has been made by the court disposing of an application without a hearing. Any party affected by this order may apply to have it set aside, varied or stayed. Any such application must be issued by 4 pm on [7 days].**

**Reasons**

**The administrators reasonably require more time to realise the assets of the Company and to make a distribution to the creditors once they have realised those assets. It is not in the interests of the creditors to incur the cost of conversion to a liquidation to continue this process.**
