Curzon Hotels (Operator) Limited (Entity) entered members' voluntary liquidation on 13 September 2019. Emma Cray and Steven Sherry were appointed joint liquidators of the Entity (Liquidators).

This report covers the conduct and progress of the liquidation in the period from 13 September 2019 to 12 September 2020 (Period).

REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

Refund

In the Period, a refund of £3,146.22 became due to the Entity from Canada Life Limited and £5,394.84 from NPower. As the Entity does not operate a bank account, the liquidators instructed Canada Life Limited and Npower to pay the refund directly to the Entity's indirect Member, AMR Hospitality (Ireland) Designated Activity Company, to hold on trust on behalf of the Entity pending formal distribution. These refunds have the effect of increasing the intercompany debtor by £8,541.06.

The Liquidators are not aware of any other assets that remain to be realised.

Settlement of liabilities:

The directors' Declaration of Solvency showed that the Entity had no liabilities.

In the Period, the Liquidators published a notice in the London Gazette inviting creditors to submit details of claims they may have against the Entity.

The Liquidators received a purported claim against the Entity however on review, it was later withdrawn.

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In the Period, the Liquidators also received another claim against the Entity from Castle Water Limited. The claim of £4,111.36 was agreed by the Liquidators and settled by AMR Hospitality (Ireland) Designated Activity Company, via the intercompany account, together with interest applicable in the Period.

No creditor claims remain outstanding.

HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC"):

In the Period, the Liquidators wrote to HMRC to inform them of the liquidation and to request details of any outstanding liabilities.

The Liquidators received a claim from HMRC. The outstanding tax liability was off set with a group tax refund due to a related entity prior to liquidation. The Liquidators have been liaising with HMRC with a view to obtaining clearance to close the liquidation as soon as possible.

No distributions were made during the Period.
