PROGRESS IN THE LIQUIDATION

Asset realisations

Receipts and payments accounts are attached at Appendix C.

No assets have been realised since our previous progress report.

The only assets known at the date of liquidation were intercompany receivables owed to the Companies which were distributed in specie to their member on 27 February 2023.

Further to this we were advised that tax refunds were due to Cheam Insurance Brokers Limited, Chris Frost Insurance Services Limited and Parish Council Insurance Brokers Ltd. Liquidation bank accounts were opened to receive the refunds, and these have now been paid to a group company.

HMRC

We are required to obtain clearances from both the Corporation Tax office, and the Enforcement & Insolvency Service which provides VAT and PAYE clearances, and which also issues HMRC's claim in respect of all taxes.

We can confirm that all tax clearances have been received for the Companies, and the refunds detailed above have been realised.

Creditors

There were no known creditors at the date of liquidation.

As previously reported, an unsecured claim of 95p was received from British Gas in respect of a property formerly owned by Cheam Insurance Brokers Limited. As this amount is negligible it has been waived. No further claims have been received.

Return on capital

First and final distributions in specie of the amounts due from group companies were made to the Companies' respective members on 27 February 2023.

Other matters

In addition to the above matters, we have dealt with all statutory matters required by legislation and administrative work incidental to our duties as Joint Liquidators in these liquidations.

Joint Liquidators' remuneration

The Joint Liquidators' remuneration was approved on a time cost basis by the members. Cumulative time costs to the date of our proposed final account of £39,681 were incurred over 118 hours at an average rate of £336 per hour.

APPENDIX B

MEMBERS' RIGHTS

Within 21 days of receipt of the Proposed Final Account, members with at least 5% in value of the total voting rights of all members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Companies or any member with the permission of court, may request in writing that the Joint Liquidators provide further information about their remuneration or expenses which have been itemised in the Proposed Final Account.

Within 14 days of receipt of the request, the Joint Liquidators must provide all of the information asked for, unless they think that:

- the time or cost in preparing the information would be excessive, or
- disclosure of the information would be prejudicial to the conduct of the liquidations or might reasonably be expected to lead to violence against any person, or
- they are subject to confidentiality obligations in respect of the information.

The Joint Liquidators are also required to give reasons for not providing all of the requested information.

Members with at least 10% in value of the total voting rights of all members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Companies may, within eight weeks of receipt of the Proposed Final Account, make an application to court that the basis fixed for the Joint Liquidators' remuneration, the remuneration charged, or the expenses incurred by the Joint Liquidators, as set out in the Proposed Final Account, are excessive.

The Joint Liquidators may conclude that the affairs of the Companies are fully wound up before 2 May 2023 if every member confirms in writing to us that they do not intend to make any request for further information about remuneration or expenses or a court application. No requests have been received.

When the affairs of the Companies are fully wound up the Joint Liquidators will make up the final account and deliver it to the members. When the final account is delivered to the Registrar of Companies the Joint Liquidators will be released under Section 171(6) of the Act.
