- 27. Notwithstanding the removal of the Applicants from the office of trustee in bankruptcy, any progress reports that are filed in relation to those estates will continue to cover the period that applied prior to making this Order, whether pursuant to Rule 6.78A(3) or (4) of the Insolvency Rules 1986 and for the avoidance of doubt, Rule 6.78A (4) shall not apply in respect of the removal of the Applicants from the office of the trustee in bankruptcy of the estates listed in the Schedules.
- 28. Insofar as they are removed from the office of administrator by this Order, the Applicants are respectively discharged from liabilities with effect from the date of this Order, pursuant to paragraph 98(2)(c) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986.
- 29. The Applicants shall notify the Secretary of State of the Order as soon as reasonably practicable after it is made.
- 30. Any cases listed in the Schedules which, pursuant to paragraph 1 above, are transferred to the High Court of Justice be transferred back to the County Court or District Registry from which they originated.

- 31. The creditors of the respective estates listed in the Schedules shall each have the right to apply to vary or discharge this order, provided such application is issued no later than 4pm on the 28th day after notification of this Order in accordance with paragraph 32 below.
- 32.
