2. PROGRESS OF THE LIQUIDATIONS

2.1 Work done during the report period

Assets and Liabilities

At the outset of the liquidation, on the basis of the Declaration of Solvency for Renewable Energy Systems Construction Limited, there were assets of £1 comprising an amount due from a fellow group undertaking and there were no liabilities held in the name of the company.

At the outset of the liquidation, on the basis of the Declaration of Solvency for RES-Gen Limited, there were assets of £5,894,180 comprising an amount due from a fellow group undertaking of £5,800,842 and trade debtors of £93,338. Liabilities totalled £33,880.

At the outset of the liquidation, on the basis of the Declarations of Solvency for RES Advisory Limited and RES Esco Limited, there were assets of £1 comprising an investment in a subsidiary undertaking and there were no liabilities held in the names of the companies.

At the outset of the liquidation, on the basis of the Declaration of Solvency for RES Solar Limited, there were assets of £2 comprising an amount due from a fellow group undertaking and there were no liabilities held in the name of the company.

According to the Declarations of Solvency for the remaining nine companies there were no assets or liabilities held in the names of these companies.

Distributions

The Liquidators have not made any distributions to the members during the report period.

Statutory Tasks

During the period we carried out the following tasks, which primarily related to fulfilment of statutory and compliance obligations and other tasks of an administrative nature:

- case set up and management;
- statutory reporting;
- appointment notifications;
- correspondence;
- case reviews; and
- general liquidation administration and filing.

These tasks are a necessary part of the engagement but do not generate any direct financial benefit for the members.

Corporation Tax

The Liquidators liaised directly with Renewable Energy Systems Limited on all matters relating to the Companies' tax affairs. There was one outstanding pre-liquidation corporation tax return to be filed in respect of each of the Companies (i.e. for the period from 1 November 2015 to 28 July 2017), which were submitted to HMRC on 19 July 2017. Formal tax clearance for the closure of the liquidations was requested from HMRC 29 August 2017, to which we are awaiting a response.

VAT

The Liquidators' liaised directly with Renewable Energy Systems Limited on all matters relating to the Companies' VAT affairs - nine of the 13 companies were VAT registered (i.e. all except for Keadby Limited, Passivhaus (UK) Limited, RES Enterprises Limited and RES Solar Limited). These companies have all been deregistered for VAT purposes and the outstanding VAT return (i.e. for the period from 1 May 2016 to 27.07.2016) were submitted to HMRC on 12 July 2017. VAT clearance was requested on 29 August 2017, to which we are awaiting a response.

Replacement of Liquidator

Stephen Roland Browne and Christopher Richard Frederick Day were appointed Liquidators of the Companies further to the written resolution of the members dated 28 July 2016. Ian Harvey Dean replaced Christopher Richard Frederick Day as Liquidator of the Companies on 12 May 2017, following Chris Day's retirement from Deloitte
