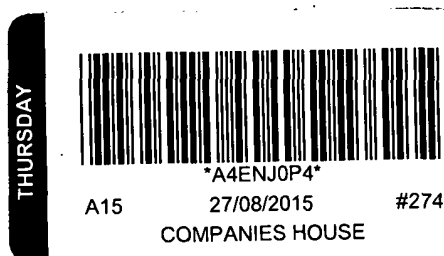

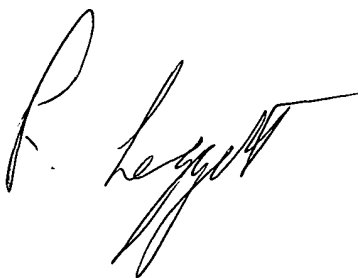

1.1. Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in Accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).
